 of age and older, through <u>AHS clinics</u>, pharmacies and physicians.

- Please note: children less than nine years of age must be immunized at an AHS Clinic. Pharmacists cannot immunize children less than nine years of age. Find a clinic for your whole family by clicking the button below.
