Criteria for the Father Walter Krewski Membership Awards

In 2007, the Albert Mackenzie CWL established the Father Walter Krewski Awards which recognized councils that strived to increase membership within their councils. This award is now an annual event at our Provincial conventions.

The awards were set up to recognize these three areas:

1. councils that recruited the largest number of brand NEW CWL members
2. councils that have strived for new members, but also work to increase their membership from the previous year
3. councils that have the greatest percentage increase in membership from the previous year. This award was intended to benefit smaller councils who do not have a large membership, but also do not have a large parish population from which to recruit members

So it gives me great pleasure to announce the recipients of these three awards for the year 2016.

This year's recipient for having the greatest increase in NEW members is St. Bonaventure in Calgary. They recruited 18 NEW members.

The greatest increase in membership goes to Ascension CWL in Calgary, which is a brand new council and they had 36 ladies that joined this new council.

The greatest percentage increase in membership goes to St. Gabriel in Calgary and they had a 92.86% increase from the previous year.

In 2016, 55 councils had an increase in membership.

I would just like to congratulate all the councils for their hard work and dedication in promoting the League and ensuring that all Catholic Women are given the opportunity to know what the Catholic Women's League of Canada is all about and the personal benefit that each woman will gain by being a member.
